16 NOV 21:21 UTC Americas Tactical (UPDATE): Hurricane Iota strengthens to Category 5, to make landfall on Nicaragua during night hours (local time) on November 16; remain cognizant of authorities' updates

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Please be advised

- The US National Hurricane Center (NHC) has confirmed that Hurricane lota has intensified into a Category 5 hurricane. Iota is due to make landfall on the northeastern coast of Nicaragua during the night hours (local time) on November 16.
- Hurricane warnings are in effect for multiple areas, including Providencia, and the coasts of Honduras and Nicaragua. Extreme winds and life-threatening storm surges are expected along portions of the coast of northeastern Nicaragua.
- The NHC has additionally issued a warning for flash flooding and landslides in Nicaragua and Honduras following the recent effects of Hurricane Eta.

Recommendations

- 1. Those operating or residing in the aforementioned regions on November 16 and over the coming days are advised to remain abreast of local authorities' updates on weather-related risks.
- 2. Allot for disruptions to travel and electricity services.
- 3. If not in an area ordered for evacuation, stay at home, close storm shutters, and stay away from windows. Secure any loose objects outdoors.
- 4. Confirm that places, where you will be located, have working generators in case of power outages while packing sufficient batteries and flashlights.
