Israel Tactical: Airspace over Golan Heights reportedly closed during morning hours (local time) of October 14; reconfirm itineraries

Please be advised:

- Reports indicate that Israeli authorities have closed the airspace over the Golan Heights to civilian aircraft during the morning hours of October 14.
- According to an unconfirmed report, the airspace closure will be in effect for the duration of October 14.
- The decision has been taken following alleged <u>Israeli airstrikes</u> in Syria's Homs Province during the overnight hours of October 13-14. The airstrikes reportedly killed one Syrian Arab Army (SAA) soldier and wounded three others.

Recommendations:

Those traveling to and from Israel on October 14 are advised to reconfirm travel itineraries due to the reported airspace closure over the Golan Heights.
