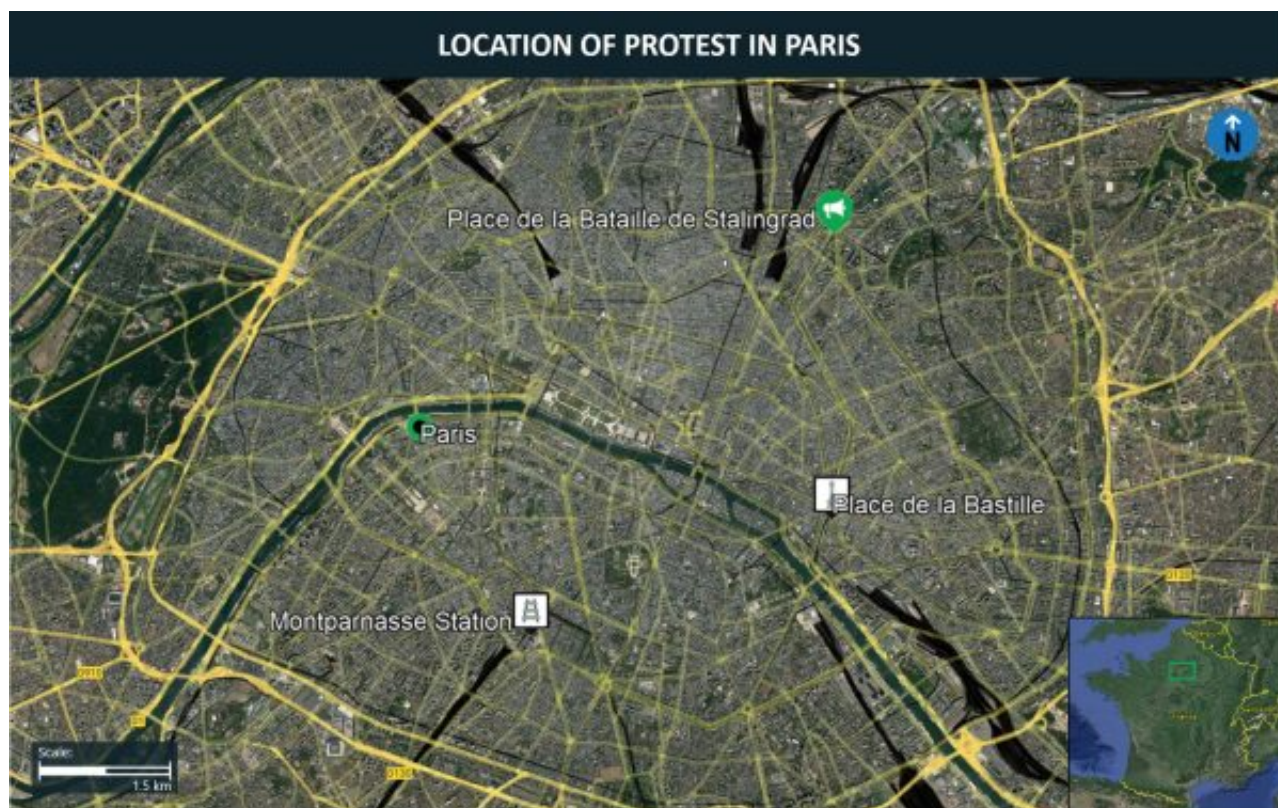

France Tactical: Protest calling for support for exiled people to be held at Place de la Bataille de Stalingrad in Paris at 15:00 (local time) on November 21; allot for disruptions

Please be advised

- A protest calling for support for exiled individuals is slated to be held at Place de la Bataille de Stalingrad in Paris at 15:00 (local time) on November 21.
- Several organizations such as Emmaus France, La Cimade, Faim aux Frontieres, and CCFD-Terre Solidaire are supporting the protest.



Assessments

Based on organizers' estimates and social media traction, the turnout for the protest is

likely to be in the low-to-mid hundreds. The protest is expected to transpire largely peacefully and without instances of major unrest. Regardless, a bolstered security presence is likely to be witnessed in the vicinity of the protest as a precaution and to monitor proceedings. Disruptions to vehicular and pedestrian traffic are anticipated during the afternoon to evening hours in the vicinity of Place de la Bataille de Stalingrad.

Recommendations

Those operating or residing in Paris on November 21 are advised to allot for disruptions to travel in the vicinity of Place de la Bataille de Stalingrad during the afternoon to evening hours.
