Canada & USA Tactical: Protests slated to take place outside Australian Consulate General in multiple cities on December 4; allot for disruptions

Please be advised

- Reports indicate that multiple civil society groups in Canada and the USA, including Children's Health Defense and Teachers for Choice, will join the international call for protests under the banner 'SOS Australia' on November 4. Protests will be held outside the Australian Consulate General in multiple cities in both countries throughout the day.
- Details regarding the exact protest locations and timings are as follows:

- The protests have been organized to denounce COVID-19-related domestic and international travel measures adopted by the Australian government, especially vaccine mandates, lockdowns, and travel restrictions, widely perceived as a violation of citizens' human rights.

Assessments

1. Based on social media estimates, the slated protests are likely to draw varying turnouts ranging in the low-to-mid hundreds, with protests in New York City and Washington, DC liable to draw the largest attendance.
2. Although the demonstrations are likely to transpire largely peacefully, a bolstered security enforcement is liable in the vicinity of the abovementioned protest locations.
3. Localized disruptions to pedestrian and vehicular traffic can be expected in the vicinity of the protest locations during the slated timings.

Recommendations

Those operating or residing in the abovementioned cities of Canada and the USA on December 4 are advised to allot for disruptions to travel in the vicinity of the abovementioned locations during the slated timings.
