13 NOV 12:06 UTC Israel Tactical: Authorities announce closure of Jerusalem's Shazar tunnel, additional lanes, for road works from November 16-27; allot for disruptions

Current Situation:

- The Jerusalem Municipality has announced that construction will take place to complete traffic arrangements in the Shazar tunnel between the hours of 23:00 to 05:00 (local time) from November 16 to 27.
- To facilitate construction, from November 16 to 20, the tunnel lane towards the exit of the city will be closed to traffic.
- Between November 23 to 27, a traffic lane leading towards Ben Zvi Boulevard and Agripas Street will be closed to traffic.
- A detour for private vehicles will be established from the intersection of Hakhil Hamishpat towards
 Sderot HaNassi Hashishi, crossing Begin Boulevard towards
- The municipality recommended drivers travel on alternate routes to avoid disruptions due to construction.
