Europe Tactical (UPDATE): Protests related to Israel-Hamas conflict to take place in multiple cities on April 16-19; maintain heightened vigilance

Current Situation

- Reports indicate that protests related to the Israel-Hamas conflict will take place in several cities regionwide on April 16-19.
- Multiple protests are organized as part of the International Day of Solidarity with Palestinian Prisoners on April 17. Details are as follows:
- In Brussels, **Belgium**, a pro-Palestinian protest will be held at Place du Luxembourg at 17:00 (local time) on April 17.
- The protest is being held in connection with the International Day of Solidarity with Palestinian Prisoners.

Assessments & Forecast

- 1. Based on precedent and the mobilizational capabilities of the organizers, protests related to the Israel-Hamas conflict are likely to attract turnouts in the low hundreds to mid-thousand each. The protests commemorating International Day of Solidarity with Palestinian Prisoners in Berlin and Paris are likely to see the largest turnouts.
- 2. In addition to the planned protests, spontaneous pro-Palestinian and pro-Israel demonstrations are likely to occur regionwide, given the commemorations of the International Day of Solidarity with Palestinian Prisoners. Protests over the conflict are likely to take place near central government buildings, main squares, and Israeli and US diplomatic missions.
- 3. Based on precedent, any planned or spontaneous demonstrations related to the Israel-Hamas conflict carry a heightened potential for unrest in the form of clashes between protesters and police. Further, the potential for pro-Israel counter-protests also remains, increasing the risk of clashes between opposing groups.
- 4. Given this, a reinforced security presence is expected near protest locations to monitor proceedings. In the case of escalating unrest, police are liable to use forcible dispersal methods, including using tear gas or conducting mass arrests.
- 5. Significant disruptions to pedestrian and vehicular movement, including road closures, disruptions

to public transportation, and traffic diversions, should be anticipated near the protest locations.

Recommendations

- 1. Those operating or residing in Europe on April 16-19 are advised to maintain heightened vigilance near protests related to the Israel-Hamas conflict due to the elevated potential for unrest.
- 2. Allot for travel-related disruptions in the vicinity of the protest locations.
