



## **Protest**





Israel Tactical: Anti-government protests slated in Tel Aviv, Jerusalem on February 15; maintain heightened vigilance

## **Current Situation:**

Anti-government activists have called for protests at several locations across **Tel Aviv** and **Jerusalem** during evening hours (local time) on February 15.

#### **Tel Aviv:**

- The "Bring Them Home" protest group has scheduled a demonstration at **Hostages Square** on **Shaul HaMelech Street** at 20:00, demanding the return of all hostages.
- Anti-government protesters will march from **HaBima Square** at 18:45, concluding at **Begin Gate**.
- Additional protests calling for the return of hostages and organized under the "Democracy March" tagline are planned at Shaul HaMelech Street and Huberman Street at unspecified times.
- The ultra-Orthodox community has announced a protest against the conscription law at **Bnei Brak's Givat Shmuel interchange**, also known as the **Coca-Cola Interchange**.
- A separate demonstration demanding the release of hostages and accountability from Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu is scheduled at **Herzliya's City Hall** at 19:30.

### Jerusalem:

- Anti-government groups have planned a protest march demanding the release of all hostages, beginning at **Zion Square** at 19:30 and heading to **Paris Square**.
- Additionally, a 24-hour vigil is set to take place outside the Prime Minister's residence (Beit Aghion) on **Balfour Street.**
