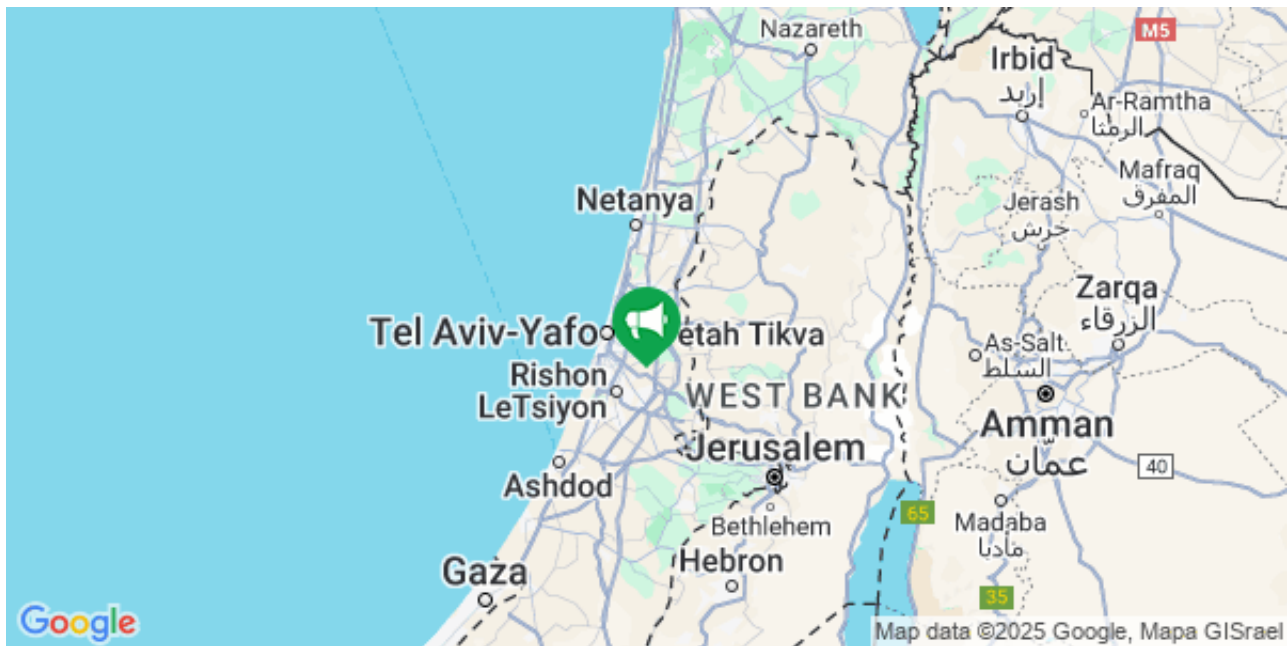

Israel Tactical (UPDATE): Workers cancel strike at Ben Gurion International airport, border crossings, during evening hours of February 28; operations may resume

Current Situation:

- Employees of Israel's Population and Immigration Authority have reportedly called off the strike at the Ben Gurion International Airport and all border crossings across the country, which was initially slated for March 2.
- The Authority stated that all border crossings, including the airport, will remain open. This follows a dialogue and agreement between the authority's workers and the government.
