Pakistan Tactical: Aurat March protest slated at Teen Talwar Monument in Karachi from 17:00 (local time) on July 22; maintain vigilance

Current Situation:

- Activists affiliated with the Aurat March group have called for a protest at Teen Talwar Monument in Karachi from 17:00 (local time) on July 22.
- The demonstration will call for further investigations and government attention to the cases of missing children in Sindh Province.

Assessments & Forecast:

1. Turnout at the slated protest is likely to range in the mid-to-high dozens, based on the mobilization capacity of the group, as well as social media response. In line with standard security protocols, the authorities can be expected to heighten security measures in the vicinity of the protest location. These measures are likely to include the deployment of police personnel and the placement of barriers to control crowds.
2. There remains a latent risk of scuffles between protesters and the police, considering the anti-government nature of the protest. Should protesters engage in behaviors perceived as disruptive, including the blocking of traffic at Teen Talwar Monument, the authorities are liable to employ crowd dispersal measures including baton charges and temporary detentions. Localized disruptions to vehicular travel are expected in the vicinity of the aforementioned location, considering turnout and related security measures during the slated protest hours on July 22.

Recommendations:

Those operating or residing in Karachi on July 22 are advised to maintain vigilance in the vicinity of Teen Talwar Monument due to the slated protest and associated risk of scuffles, while allotting for travel disruptions.
