Japan Tactical: Multiple protests slated outside Israeli Embassy, National Diet in Tokyo on April 3; allot for disruptions

Current Situation:

- Activists will hold a demonstration in front of the main gate of the National Diet in Tokyo at 13:00 (local time) on April 3.
- The protest will be held to protect the constitution with reference to proposed changes in Article 9, which renounces war.
- Pro-Palestinian activists are slated to protest outside the Israeli Embassy in Tokyo from 19:00 to 20:00 on April 3.
- The protest aims to denounce Israel's recently adopted law expanding the use of the death penalty against Palestinians convicted under terrorism provisions.

Assessments & Forecast:

The turnout at the slated demonstrations will likely range in the low-to-mid dozens, given the respective mobilization capabilities of the organizing groups. Anticipating this, the authorities are expected to bolster security measures in the vicinity of the aforementioned locations, particularly outside the Israeli Embassy and the National Diet, given the sensitivity of the locations. These measures are likely to include the deployment of police personnel and the setting up of barricades to monitor the proceedings. Nevertheless, the protests are anticipated to transpire peacefully, given the precedent. Localized disruptions to pedestrian and vehicular travel are expected in the vicinity of the aforementioned locations due to the slated protests and associated security measures on April 3.

Recommendations:

Those operating or residing in Tokyo from April 3 are advised to allot for travel disruptions in the vicinity of the aforementioned locations due to the slated protests.
